**INTERNSHIP 6 – 8 WEEKS (3 CREDIT HOURS)****NOTE:**

- ✧ Registration for new term of old students starts in the 8th week of the previous term.
- ✧ Master's student must opt for courses falling in two consecutive semesters. Students must clear one module courses completely before taking next module courses.
- ✧ A Probation student (CGPA below 3.00) cannot take more than three (3) courses in a term.
- ✧ Students are responsible to meet the pre-requisite of a course at the time of registration.
- ✧ Students are not allowed to take major courses before clearing core requirements.
- ✧ A course in a term is only offered if minimum ten (10) students are registered in that course, therefore registration during the time of registration period is very important.
- ✧ Student applying for Challenge examination should attach challenge examination form for that course with the registration form.
- ✧ Student wishing to drop semester after filling the registration form must write immediately separate application, otherwise an "F" grade will recorded on the transcript.
- ✧ Student wishing to withdraw from courses must follow the dates and write a separate application within the time frame for withdrawal; otherwise an "F" grade will be recorded on the transcript.
