IMPORTANT:

1. A course will not be offered, if less than 10 students are enrolled.
2. A Graduate student on probation i.e. GPA below 3.0 cannot take more than four (04) courses in a semester. After probation of three semesters, they will be placed on dean vacation.
3. The approval granted will be PROVISIONAL. A student will only be allowed regular admission into the programme after his/her accumulated GPA has been calculated on the basis of all the results of the courses he / she had taken in the previous semesters.
4. A student may not take courses falling in more than two consecutive modules in a semester. Thus a student while taking any or all courses of Module-I must not take a course or courses of Module-II.
5. He / She must clear all subjects of Module – I before he / she may be permitted to take courses in Module – II.
6. Every student is required to list all courses that he / she has already passed or the courses that he/she is awaiting results of. In the later case, under “Grade” words “RA” (Result Awaited) should be written. If the grades are not entered, approval will not be granted.
7. Once the registration form has been filled, a student is considered as a registered student. If at a later date, a student drops the semester, he / she has to write an application to the Registrar (within due date) informing of the same: otherwise, an ‘F’ Grade will be recorded on the transcript against the courses in which he / she was enrolled.
8. Students are responsible for clearing core requirements first before starting major courses.
9. Students are responsible for clearing the pre-requisites.
10. ATTENDANCE: Students MUST maintain 80% class attendance; otherwise, they will not be allowed to sit for their examinations.
11. Internship is mandatory for all Under-Graduate students.
12. Dissertation / Research Project is Mandatory for all Graduate Students under the new degree structure
13. Courses which have been dropped / substituted from modules are mentioned on Module form.
14. Those students who wish to follow the old degree structure, must mention it on their registration forms.
15. Those students who have completed their Bachelors degree with 120 credit hours, have to complete 45 credit hours for their Masters degree.

A course marked with an asterisk (*) is meant only for those students who wish to pursue the old degree structure.
